TUITION FEES

For the 2023-2024 academic year, international students from outside the European Union will benefit from a partial exemption from tuition fees, allowing them to pay an amount of tuition equal to that paid by national and EU students. This exemption is valid for the academic year 2023-2024.

11. COMING TO SAINT-ETIENNE

BY PLANE

From Lyon Saint-Exupéry airport:

OUIBUS bus: this is the fastest and most economical solution.

→ Choose the "Lyon Airport - Saint-Etienne" route.

Carpooling: there are many carpooling offers between Lyon Saint-Exupéry and Saint-Etienne via the Blablacar website.

Rhônexpress + train:

From Saint-Exupéry airport, take the Rhônexpress to the Lyon Part-Dieu station.

Every 15 minutes from 6am to 9pm, every 30 minutes from 5am to 6am and from 9pm to midnight.

One way ticket for young people from 12 to 25 years old : 13 €.

Reservation on the website or directly at the terminals on site.

From Lyon Part-Dieu station, take a TER train to Saint-Etienne Châteaueux station.

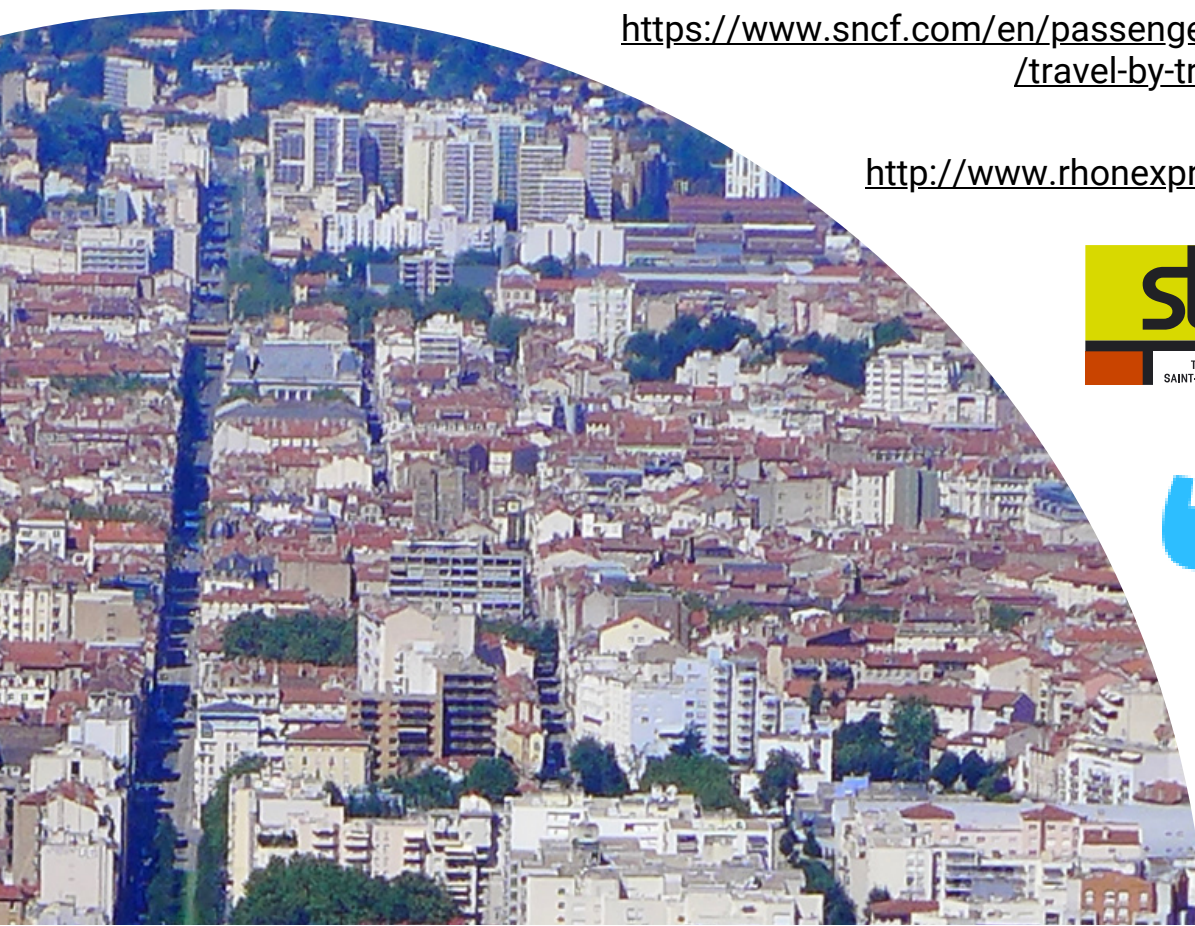
BY TRAIN

From Paris or Lyon, you can arrive at the station of Saint-Etienne Châteaueux (main station).

Frequency: trains arrive or leave almost every hour for Lyon.

Two direct trains per day to Paris (2h50), others stop in Lyon for a change of 10 to 40 minutes.

From Lyon Part-Dieu station, take a TER train to Saint-Etienne Châteaueux station.
