A French engineering school

Telecom Saint Etienne (TSE) is an integral part of the Université Jean Monnet in Saint-Etienne and an associate member of the Institut Mines-Télécom, TSE trains around 500 engineers each year in electronics, optics/photonics, telecommunications, computer networks, computer vision, computer science and informatics.

French-speaking students

A minimum B2 level in French is required

French-speaking students can join our program throughout the engineering curriculum for 1 or 2 semesters:

- The winter semester runs from early September to late January.
- The summer semester runs from mid-February to June.

Note that the final year of the program (M2 level) consists of an academic semester and an internship lasting a minimum of 20 weeks (mid-February to August/September).



English-speaking students

A minimum B2 level in English is required

English-speaking students can join our program for one or two semesters at M2 level. This year of the curriculum is made up of an academic semester (September to February) and an internship lasting a minimum of 20 weeks (mid- February to August/September).

During the academic semester, 3 program tracks are available for English-speaking students:



Exceptionally, depending on the lecturer, some courses may not be taught in English. In such cases, the student will be offered either another course taught in English, or the opportunity to take part in a research project with one of the school's professors or associate-professors. The work required will be adapted to the number of ECTS credits to be validated.
