## Administrative procedures

---

### School fees

#### Exchange students

**Tuition fees:** you do not pay any fees at Télécom Saint-Etienne. You must register at your home university.

#### Students admitted via competitive examination or on “Etudes en France” (Free Mover)

For the academic year 2021-2022, international students from outside the EU benefit from a partial exemption from tuition fees, allowing them to pay an amount of tuition fees equal to that paid by national and EU students. This exemption is valid for the 2021-2022 academic year.

### Documents for registration

#### Exchange students

- Identity card or passport
- Student card from your home institution for the year of your mobility
- A copy of your 2020/2021 transcript
- A learning agreement signed by the study coordinator

#### Students admitted via competitive examination or on “Etudes en France” (Free Mover)

- Passport
- A birth certificate and its translation (for students outside Europe)
- A copy of your 2020/2021 transcript

### Student social security (compulsory)

## Residence permit

---

### Visa

- Students from the European Union and the European Economic Area are exempt from visa requirements.
- Students from outside the European Union must apply for a Long Stay Student Visa from the French Consulate or Embassy in their country of residence. You must register on the [Etudes en France](#) application.

**Carpooling:** there are many carpooling offers between Lyon Saint-Exupéry and Saint-Etienne via the Blablacar website.

### Rhôneexpress and train:

From Saint-Exupéry airport, take the Rhôneexpress to Lyon Part-Dieu station. Every 15 minutes from 6am to 9pm, every 30 minutes from 5am to 6am and from 9pm to midnight. Ticket for Young people from 12 to 25 years old €13. Reservation on the website or directly at the terminals on site. From Lyon Part-Dieu station, take a TER train to Saint-Etienne Châteaureux.

- **By train**

From Paris or Lyon, you can arrive at Saint-Etienne Châteaureux station (main station). Frequency: Trains arrive or leave almost every hour for Lyon. Two direct trains per day to Paris (2h50), others stop in Lyon for a 10 to 40-minute change.

From Lyon Part-Dieu station, take a TER train to Saint-Etienne Châteaureux.

### Tramway

A tramway line crosses the city from north to south and also links the Châteaureux station to the city centre.
